

## DIGITAL TICKETS

All hospitality tickets will be digital and available in the AIGWO Tickets App. You will receive an email inviting you to download the AIGWO Tickets App to access your tickets.

Once you have downloaded the app and created an account with the same email address that is attached to your hospitality booking, you will be able to view your tickets. We encourage you to transfer tickets to your guests and have your individual ticket on your own device.

## HOSPITALITY PARKING

Your parking pass will be digital and distributed alongside your hospitality tickets in the AIGWO Tickets App. Please have your digital pass ready for scanning upon entry to the car park.

Parking for The Champions Club is located within the **Green A Car Park**. If using the M4, please exit at junction 37 and follow AA event signage to Green Car Parks. If you are arriving in a larger vehicle such as a Minibus, parking will be available in the Green A Car Park also. Please note that vehicles cannot be left overnight in the car park. Once parked, please follow signs for the entrance gates.

A Pick Up and Drop Off area will also be located within the Green A Car Park, but will require a separate digital pass. Please contact us directly for a pass.

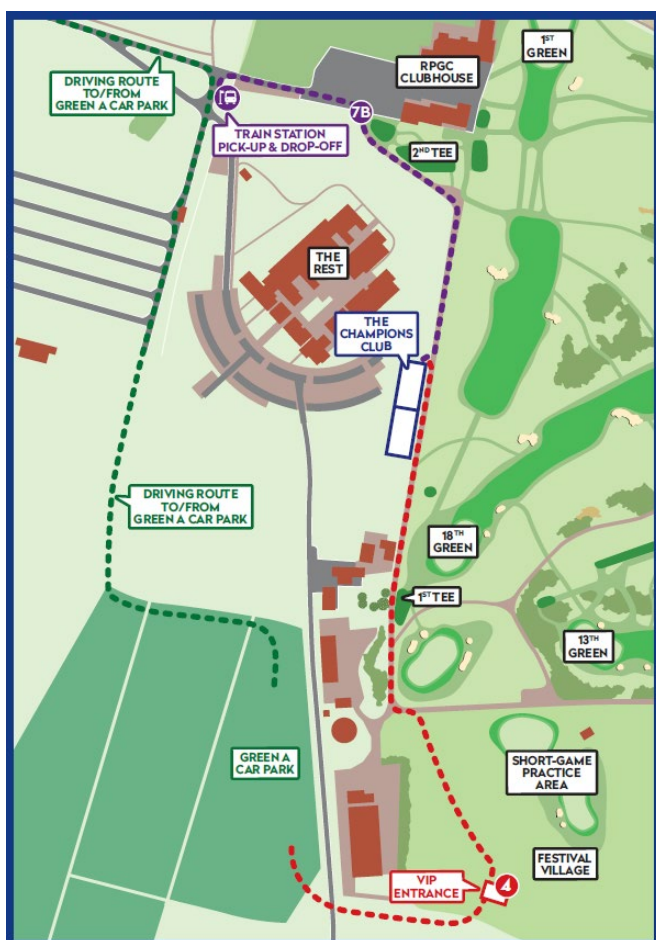
## TRAIN

The closest train station to Porthcawl is Bridgend Station from where a complimentary bus service will transfer you to the course and back. These buses provide a low-carbon service run on hydrogen or hydrotreated vegetable oil which reduces carbon emissions by approximately 94% compared to fossil diesel across the Championship week – that's a saving of over 4 tons of CO<sub>2</sub>!

## ACCESS TO THE COURSE & THE CHAMPIONS CLUB

Your entrance will be via the main entrance (Gate 4). Upon arrival, all hospitality guests will have access to the VIP Lane situated on the left-hand side of the entrance gate to facilitate smooth entry. Please look out for VIP signage and have your digital ticket ready for scanning as you approach the gate.

The Champions Club will be located to the left of the 1<sup>st</sup> fairway with views onto the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and 18<sup>th</sup> green. Please show your digital ticket the first time you enter the suite to gain access.

## DRESS CODE

## GRANDSTANDS

Seated Grandstands will be available by the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and 18<sup>th</sup> green. A standing viewing platform will be available at the 17<sup>th</sup> green. Accessible viewing areas will be adjacent to all grandstands and viewing platforms.

## ACCESSIBILITY

The Champions Club will have disabled access via an external lift. An accessible toilet will be available within the pavilion.

Hard-standing and wheelchair friendly accessibility parking will be available in our [Blue A Car Park](#), located by the RPGC Clubhouse. To enter the Blue A Car Park please follow AA event signage and present your Blue Badge or international equivalent on arrival, along with your digital ticket. Upon entry to the course from the car park, surfaces leading to The Championship Club will be flat tarmac, but please note an initial incline as you enter the venue.

Should you require an accessibility parking pass and/or have any accessibility requirements while in The Champions Club, please contact us prior to your arrival.
